

**National Visa – Temporary Stay****E1 – Art.54, no.1 al a): Medical treatment – Medical establishments officially recognized:**

- Medical report;
- Certificate issued by the health establishment recognizing that the applicant has assured the admission and/or the clinical treatment.

E2 - Art.55: Staff transfers of the World Trade Organization (WTO) to provide services and/or for professional training purposes:

- Documents proving the internal transfer of the company or to other company of the same group applies on partners and/or company staff members for one year as minimum duration, senior managers decisions-makers, specified staff considered essential for the company activities or that attending to receive a professional training.

E3 – Art.56: Professional company activities or private independent activities that by default doesn't exceed 6 months:

- Employment contract or a promise of an employment contract, maximum duration 6 months;
- Declaration from *Instituto de Emprego e de Formação Profissional (IEFP)*, Institution for Employment and Professional Training, mentioning that the offer is available for citizens abroad;
- Or an employment work contract from a company, or providing services in the field of independent activities (independent activities).

E4 – Art.57: Scientific investigation, Teachers/Professors of Higher Education, High ranked qualification, for 1 year duration:

- Employment contract;
- Contract for providing services;
- Research grant (identifying the education establishment that must be recognized by the Ministry of Education and Science and evidences for means of subsistence for the applicant).

E5 – Art.54, no.1 al e): Amateur sport activities:

- Certificate of federation involved confirming the respective sport event;
- Written responsibility term by the association or the respective sport club assuming responsibility for accommodation, health and repatriation expenses to original country.

E6 – Art.54, no.1 al f): staying in National Territory for longer than 3 month, exceptional cases dully justified namely accomplishment of International Commitments:

- Proof of the exceptionality;
- Providing Services Contract;
- Certification of technical qualifications for providing services.

E7 - Art.54, no.1 al g): Accompanying a patient familiar:

- Document that proves the kinship;
- Medical report;
- Certificate issued by the health establishment recognizing that the applicant has assured the admission and/or the clinical treatment.

National Visas – Commune documents for all Visa types
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- Application form, fulfilled and signed by the applicant;
- Two documents type recent equal photographs, colored, white background, in good shape for identification;
- Criminal Record (for applicants of age) issued by competent Authorities of his/her nationality country or issued by competent Authorities where he/she lives longer than one year;
- Fulfill the application form provided by the Consular Section authorizing investigation of the Portuguese Criminal Record;
- Proofs of means of subsistence;
- Valid travel insurance that covers the necessary fees for health situations that includes assistance in emergency cases, and eventually repatriation.
- Form provided by the Consular Post upon delivery of the remaining documents.

National Visas – Temporary Stay

The Temporary Visa is a National Visa **valid for four (4) months**, allows **multiple entries** and enables its bearer to enter the Portuguese territory, **in seven specific situations**, accordingly to the stay objective.

These National Temporary Visa are renewable for a maximum duration of one year – except for practicing an independent or subordinated activity – duration of 90 days.

The deadline for a decision for this Visa type is up to 30 days from the requirement presentation date. The mandatory SEF decision is given within 20 days.
